He is a Fellow of the British Psychoanalytical Society, a member of the Institute of Group Analysis, a full member of the Group Analytic Society International and a Distinguished Fellow of the American Group Psychotherapy Association. A supervisor and training analyst for the Institute of Group Analysis, and other organizations in the United Kingdom. An Honorary Tutor at The Tavistock and Portman NHS Trust and a member of the Faculty of the Post-Doctoral Program at Adelphi University, New York. A former President of the International Association

for Group Psychotherapy and Group Processes (IAGP), and a former Chairman of the Association of Independent Psychoanalysts of the British Psychoanalytical Society. The author of many books and articles in sociology, psychoanalysis and group analysis, Dr Hopper is the Editor of the New International Library of Group Analysis (NILGA).
